

STEPS REQUIRED FOR ACCESS TO ANIMAL BIOCONTAINMENT FACILITIES

1. Must have a biosafety protocol approved by the Environmental Health and Safety Office (EHSO). <http://www.ehso.emory.edu/> 404-727-5688
 - a. Note: This may involve medical clearance
2. Must have an approved IACUC protocol. <http://www.emory.edu/IACUC/> 404-727-0734
 - a. Note: This may involve medical clearance
3. Personnel must be listed on both the biosafety and IACUC protocols.

Steps 1 - 3 must be completed prior to step 4

4. Attend DAR general biosafety training. Schedule by emailing the following to DAR Security, ktroyer@dar.emory.edu 404-727-8991 :
 - a. Name
 - b. Lab Phone #
 - c. PI Name
 - d. IACUC Protocol #
 - e. Biosafety protocol
 - f. Name of the virus you will be working with
 - g. Name of the building you will be doing BSL work in

Step 4 must be completed prior to step 5

5. Contact the facility supervisor for the building in which your work will be conducted to arrange an on-site orientation to the biocontainment room. Contact information is distributed at general orientation.
6. All steps must be completed before biocontainment access is granted
