Visitor Policy

1. For reasons of security, public health and animal health, anyone wishing to visit the animal facilities must register with the Division of Animal Resources office (Whitehead G02, phone: 727-7423) and/or the departmental office in which the facilities are located.
 2. Visitors may not enter animal facilities without the permission of the Director of the Division of Animal Resources or faculty supervisors for departmental areas. All visitors must be accompanied by their faculty sponsor, or by a member of the Division of Animal Resources staff.
 3. Children (less than 18 years of age) are prohibited from entering the facilities at all times.
 4. Staff access to animal facilities is limited to those persons whose assigned duties require that they enter the facilities.
